Graduation Requirements: 26 total credits

1 credit = full year class, ½ credit = semester class

English - 4 including English I, II, III, IV

Math - 4, including one class more advanced than Algebra II, must take all four years.

Science - 3, including Biology I and Chemistry I

World Languages - 2 consecutive in the same language, Latin does not count

Social Studies - 3, including 1 credit U.S. History, 1/2 credit American Government. World History is required for all students except those enrolled in Latin II or math doublers.

P.E. - 1

Practical Arts - 1 (computers, yearbook, lit magazine, journalism, digital photo)

Fine Arts - 1 (choir, instrumental, forensics, art, drama), maximum of 5 credits all years

Religion - 4, maximum of 4 (including Religion I, II, III (Hebrew Scriptures), IV (Faith-Filled Life & Senior Service Project), and 2 religion electives taken during junior and senior years)
