Graduation Requirements:

25.5 total credits

English - 4

Math - 4, including one class more advanced than Algebra II, must take all four years.

Science - 3, including Biology I and Chemistry I

Modern Foreign Language - 2 consecutive in the same language

Social Studies - 3, including 1 credit American History, 1/2 credit American Government. World History is required for all students except those enrolled in Latin or math doublers.

P.E. - 1

Practical Arts - 1 (computers, yearbook, lit magazine, journalism, digital photo)

Fine Arts - 1 (choir, instrumental, forensics, art, drama)

Religion - 3.5, maximum of 4 (including Religion I, II, III (Biblical Traditions), IV (Faith-Filled Life), and 2 religion electives taken during junior and senior years)
