Please explain why you have selected each one.**
2. **There are several scenes in the movie where Patch and his colleagues were trying to “reach” other people when they were hurt and most vulnerable. Pick one of the scenes where you believe that either “deep listening” or “radical hospitality” was being demonstrated and link that scene to ANY QUOTE from your Radical Hospitality text. Please note the chapter and page of the quote at the end of your reflection.**
