Select one of the topics from the left box and one chapter from the "Radical Hospitality" book and express through one of the following projects, why you believe they are foundational for service as a peer minister.

- **CD COVER:**

Create a CD cover (hand-drawn or using your computer). Your selected topic and/or excerpt from the chapter must be the title for the CD. Select five songs (any genre), which reflect your selections, and list them on the back cover. Be sure to include the name of the song and the artist. You must also include the words to all of the songs on separate sheet(s) of paper. The words can be reduced to 9 font size, thus reducing paper waste. In the side margins of the lyrics, for each song, make reference to class handouts, your notes, and detailed excerpts from the chapter in connecting songs to the topic and chapter.

- **COLLAGE**

Create a collage of words and images from newspapers, internet sources and magazines based on your selected topic and the chapter. There must be at least 2 phrases from your selected topic and two from the chapter included in the collage and *at least* 16 pieces of *cut out prints* pasted onto the page. The page must be at least 11x 14 inches.

- **ESSAY**

Compose a minimum 400 minimum word essay stating why you believe your selected topic and chapter are foundational for a peer minister. The essay must be typed, 12 font size, Times New Roman, double spaced with one inch margins on all sides. Your name and the title of the essay are one inch from the top of the page. You must include 2 references to the topic and two from your selected chapter.

Project: 30 points, Presentation to class: 10 points
